**Title:** The Heart of Worship (Part 2) **Speaker:** Pastor David Menard, 6/2/2024

**Discussion Starter** – What stood out to you the most in the way King David's worship is described in 2 Samuel Chapter 6 and describe in your own words what it looks like to have a heart of worship towards God?

## **Read 2 Samuel 6:1-9:**

- 1) What did David's desire to move the Ark reveal about his passion for God? How can our passions often caus us to stumble?
- 2) Why do you think David did not know how the Ark was to be moved?
- 3) What are some of the interesting points about the Ark or about the articles that were in the Ark that you learned about from the sermon? How do each of the items point specifically to the person of Jesus Christ?
- 4) How did the Israelites inappropriately desire to use the Ark? What was their misunderstanding of what the Ark really represented?
- 5) Why was King David so intent on bringing the Ark of the Covenant back to Jerusalem?
- 6) Why do you think God struck Uzzah dead when he reached out to try to grab hold of the Ark?
- 7) Describe the progression you see King David follow after he sees God strikes Uzzah dead. What lessons can we learn from David experience about the proper reverence and obedience to God's Word?
  - a) Describe a time in your life where you were became angry or were tempted to be angry with God?
- 8) What was wrong with the worship that was taking place in verses 1-9? **Read John 4:23-24.**
- 9) Why do you think David became angry, and who do you think he was angry with?

## Read 2 Samuel 6:10-15:

- 10) What do you think God was showing David when he left the Ark with Obed-Edom for three months?
- 11) What are some of the things we can learn from David as he sings with all of his heart? **Read 1 Chronicles**15:27-28 What additional insights are gained from this passage?

## Read 2 Samuel 6:16-23:

- 12) What was David's wife, Michal's, response to David worshipping with reckless abandon?
- 13) What does Michal's response reveal about her heart and her walk with the Lord?
- 14) How did David's worship, as described in this passage, encompass all 4 Activities mentioned in the sermon?
  - b) Which of the four areas of worship is God encouraging you to grow in? What is your next step?
