Title: Living with an Eternal Lens

Discussion Starter – How do you view extremely temporary possessions, like paper plates differently than you view a longer term possession, like an automobile? How would your life be different if you fully viewed the temporary nature of this life as Paul describes in this chapter of 2 Corinthians 5?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:1-15

- 1. What metaphor does Paul use to describe our earthly bodies in 2 Corinthians 5:1? How does this metaphor help us to understand the temporary nature of our physical existence and current hardships?
- 2. What has God provided to assure us of our eternal body? (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- 3. How does a biblical understanding of death coupled with the assurance of the Holy Spirit impact how we live for Jesus?
 - a) Reflect on a recent hardship or suffering you have experienced. How can viewing your body as a temporary tent help you with hope and faith through a difficult time?
 - b) How does this understanding affect your goals and priorities for your life?
- 4. What is Paul's reaction to this confident assurance of eternal life?
- 5. What is the significance of the "Bema Seat of Christ" as described in 2 Corinthians 5:10? How does this differ from the Great White Throne Judgment?
- 6. Why is it important for believers to understand the concept of the Bema Seat of Christ? How should this knowledge impact our actions and motivations?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21

- 7. What does it mean to be a new creation in Christ? Considering the prior context, what "old things" have passed away?
 - c) In what ways can you live out your identity as a new creation in Christ this week? Identify one specific area of your life where you can demonstrate this transformation.
 - d) Do you have long-term plans that might be re-evaluated considering these particular truths?
- 8. What ministry have we been given by God? What is our motivation to fulfill this calling, (verse 14)?
