Title: The Gift of Hope

Discussion Starter – Do you have special memories that are associated with Christmas? Why is Christmas often thought of as a time of hope? How would you define "hope"? What makes hope different from wishing?

Read Genesis 3:1-6

- 1. What appears to be the goal of the serpent in this narrative? What is his strategy in approaching the woman?
- 2. Why was the knowledge of good and evil forbidden to humans? What was to be their guidance for their life in this garden?
- 3. How many ways did the serpent change God's word as he tempted her to disobey God? How did the woman respond to the serpent's claims?
- 4. What 3 avenues of temptation does the woman face? How are these similar or different from 1 John 2:16-17?
 - a. How does accurate knowledge of God's Word provide us with understanding during temptation? What is required beyond knowledge of God's word to achieve ultimate victory?
 - b. What model did Jesus give to address temptation?

Read Genesis 3:7-13

- 5. What is the human's first realization after they eat the forbidden fruit? What was promised by the serpent in verse 5?
- 6. Who initiates the separation between God and man following the act of disobedience? Who initiates the restoration of the relationship?
- 7. What excuses are offered in response to God's questions of the humans? What is God's seeking to accomplish in His questions?
 - c. Do you justify your bad behaviors to others? To God? To yourself?

Genesis 3:14-24

- 8. What great promise for humankind is embedded in the curse of the serpent? How is it fulfilled, (Hebrews 2:14-15)?
- 9. What is the meaning of the name Eve? Why is her name significant?
- 10. What did God's provide for Adam and Eve in response to their sin? What was foreshadowed in His provision?
 - d. The hope of victory over the serpent was given to humankind in Genesis. What is your response to God's fulfillment of His promise? (Romans 15:13)
